Through one-to-one conversations by phone and/or online, the ART team, including bilingual (Spanish/English) associates and a Financial Access Specialist, provide a wide array of support and information on autism and autism-related programs and services.

- ART has responded to over 535,000 requests for assistance since 2007.
- ART responded to more than 70,000 inquiries in 2021 alone.
- ART is comprised of 10 associates, including four bilingual associates and one specialized financial access associate.
