

## WPS ADI-R Training:

1. Nature of the training. WPS offers video-based clinical training on the Autism Diagnostic Interview-Revised (ADI-R). The ADI-R is an advanced clinical instrument used in the diagnosis of autism. It can be used with children and adults with a mental age above 2.0 years. It is recommended that all professionals using the ADI-R for clinical purposes complete the video-based training (offered through WPS as the "ADI-R DVD Training Package").
2. Training details:
  - a. Trainer. The ADI-R DVD Training Package was created by ADI-R authors.
  - b. Trainees. Any individual who intends to use the ADI-R for diagnostic purposes must have the necessary qualifications. In most locations, this requires a doctoral-level education and state licensure as an independent practitioner. The ADI-R can also be used for purposes other than making a diagnosis. ADI-R examiners should have prior education, training and experience in the use of individual clinical interviewing and a background in and experience providing professional services to individuals with ASD. Individuals who meet these qualifications may complete the ADI-R DVD Training Package. Other professionals who provide services to individuals with ASD, but who do not intend to use the ADI-R in practice, may also benefit from the training, as it may improve their understanding of the ADI-R to make better use of reports and recommendations that other professionals make on the basis of ADI-R results.
    - i. The DVD Training Package can be used to train multiple professionals working at the same location.
  - c. Frequency. N/A

  - e. Manual. The ADI-R Manual can be purchased from WPS, along with the other necessary assessment materials.
3. Evidence-base. There is extensive research evidence supporting the use of the ADI-R for diagnostic purposes. Information can be found in the ADI-R Manual and in the scholarly research literature.
